**Tiger Coaching Staff**

EHS Baseball Head Coach Tim Funkhouser and 2016 IHSBCA Hall of Fame inductee will serve as the camp director. Coach Funkhouser enters his 23<sup>rd</sup> season at the helm of the Tigers and his staff has led them to a 679-167 record. The Tigers have reached the IHSA Elite 8 nine times (2019 State Champions 2002 & 2017- Runner-Up) and have won ten SWC titles during his tenure. The Tigers were ranked as high as #4 in the nation in 2004 & #7 in 2015 & #26 in 2019. The camp staff will also include members of the Tiger coaching staff, current/former players and current college players. The coaching staff will place an emphasis on fundamental skill development by using several of the same drills which have continued to elevate the Tigers as a premier program in the Metro St. Louis Area, State of Illinois and even nationally. Since 1999, 128 players have moved on to play at the collegiate level.

**Facilities**

All Tiger Baseball Camps are held at the EHS Sports Complex. Tom Pile Field features a natural grass surface, multiple batting stations, concession stand, restrooms and locker room. The JV Field has newly renovated artificial turf surface. The facilities are one of the best in the region.

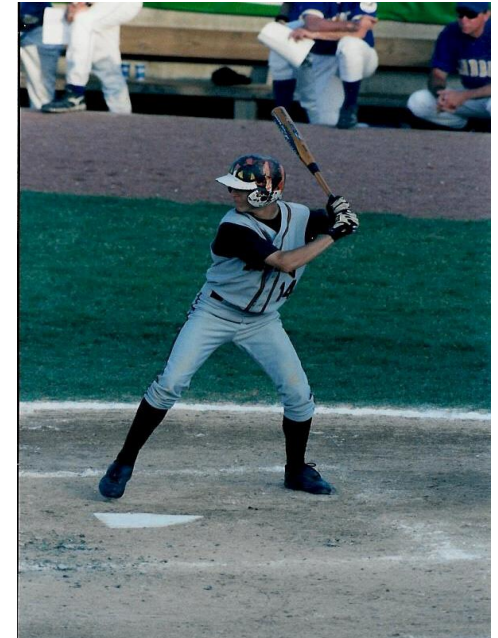

## **Tiger Advanced Hitting Camps (3<sup>rd</sup>-9<sup>th</sup>) June 20-22**

### **Hourly: (8am/9am/10am/11am)**

The Tiger Advanced Hitting Camps focus on a more in-depth view of hitting. Hitters will develop through progression drills including dry swings, tee, toss and use of machines within an hour each day. A 5-to-1 student to instructor ratio will be provided. Space is limited! Reservations are on first-come, first-serve basis. A member of the coaching staff will email (or call) with confirmation of reservation within 2 weeks of receiving registration. Free T-Shirt will be provided!

## **Tiger Baseball Academy (6<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup>) Hitting-Fielding Instruction & Analysis June 20-22 (8am/ 9:30am / 11am)**

The Tiger Baseball Academy is designed for the most comprehensive instruction. The daily 1 ½ hour session includes fundamental skill development for both hitting and defensive play. Instruction will be reinforced through use of a Rapsodo, Blastmotion and video analysis. Written evaluations will be included to aid in continued development. A 4-to1 student to instructor ratio will be provided. Limited space available! Reservations are on first-come, first-serve basis.
