

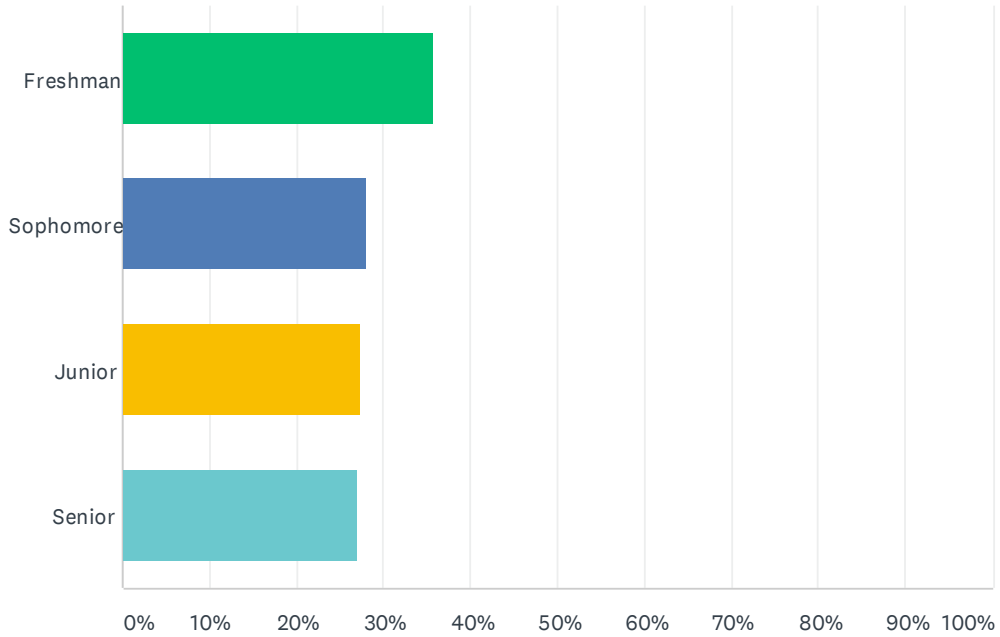

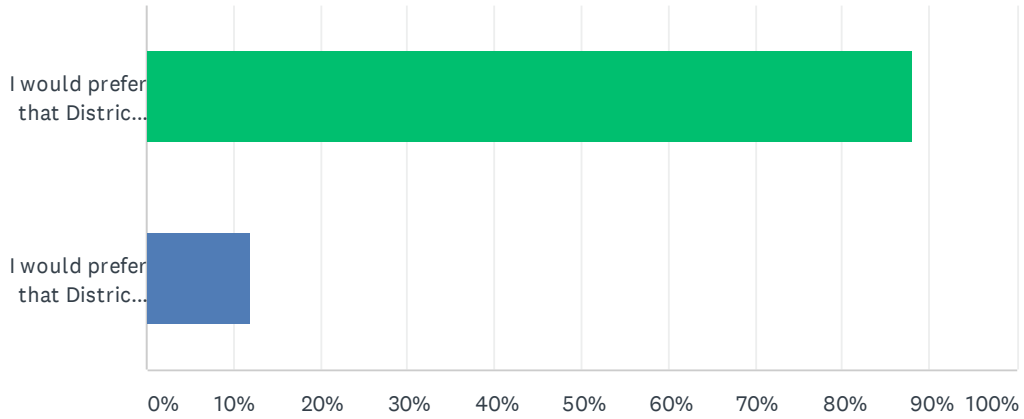

### Q4 If five days of in-person instruction per week is not possible, what would you prefer for your child(ren)?

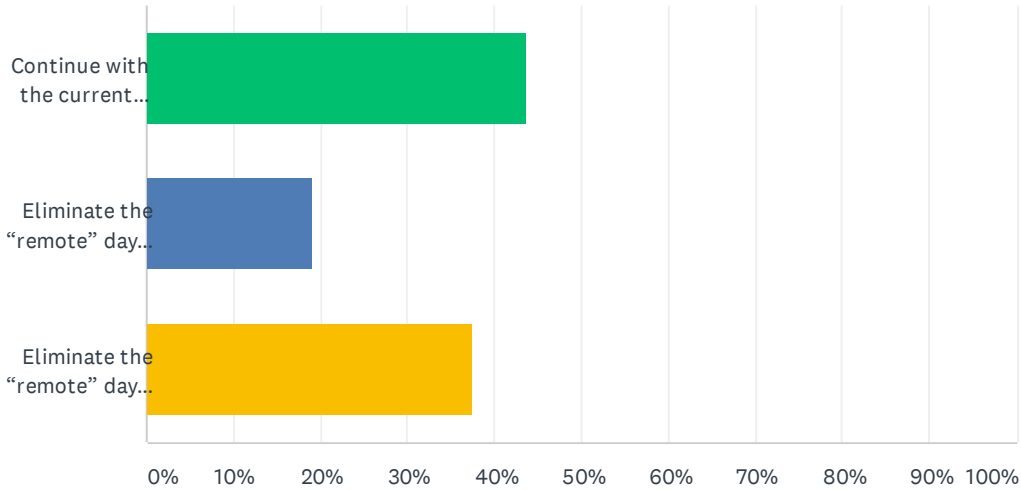

### Q5 If District 7 stayed in a hybrid schedule for an extended period of time, what would you prefer for your child(ren)?

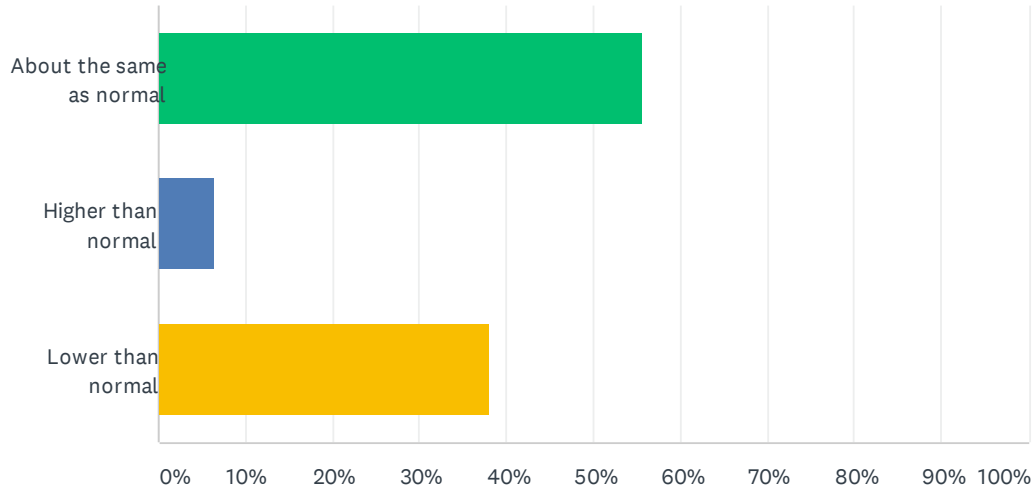

Continue with the current hybrid schedule with remote days on Fridays of five day weeks.	43.68% 491
Eliminate the "remote" days and move to a hybrid schedule that is an "A" day followed by a "B" day regardless of day of the week. In this type of schedule, the "all remote" day is eliminated. Students would attend every other day regardless of the day of the week. This is essentially an "every other day" schedule for students. If an "A" falls on a Friday, the next Monday starts with a "B".	18.95% 213
Eliminate the "remote" days and continue with the current hybrid schedule of A on Monday/Wednesday and B on Tuesday/Thursday but rotate a third in-person day on Fridays instead of remote. So one week "A" group would go on Friday and one week "B" group would go on Friday.	37.37% 420

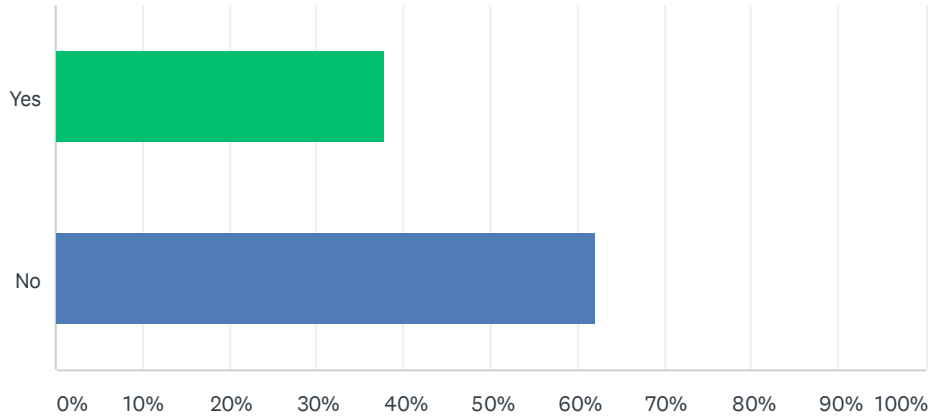

### Q7 Do you feel that the hybrid schedule of attending in-person two days a week has had an adverse effect on your child’s mental health?

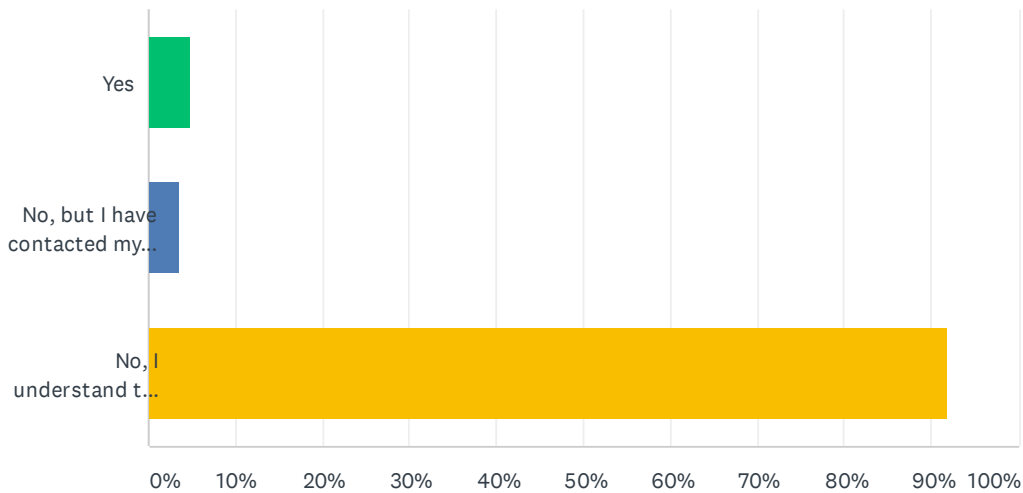

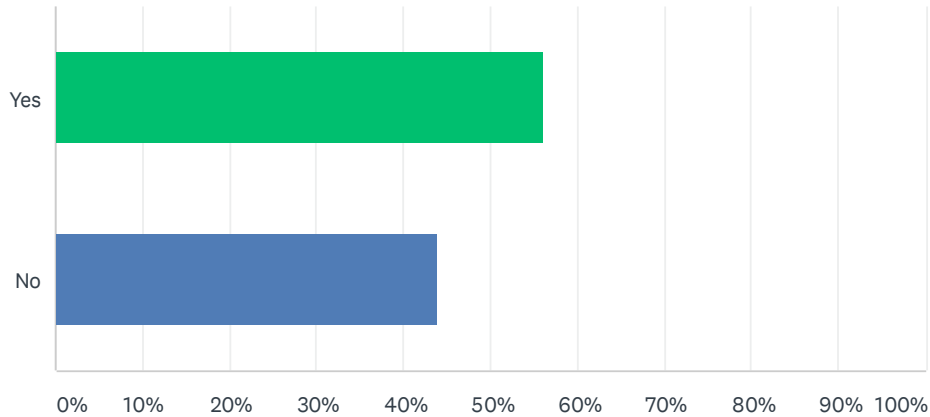

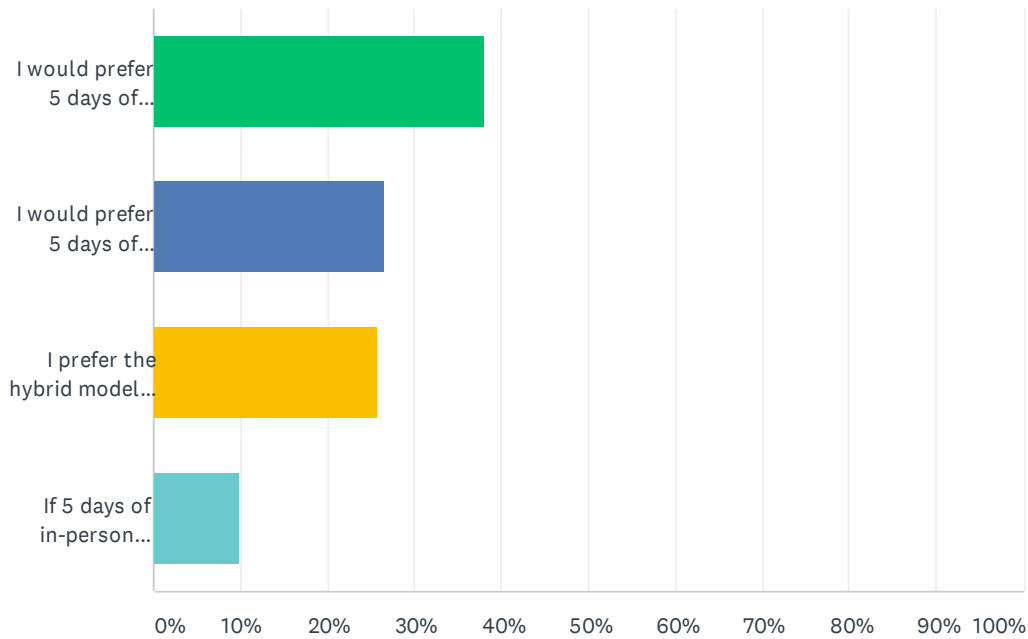

I would prefer 5 days of in-person instruction per week as soon as possible during second semester regardless of how high the Madison County COVID metrics (ie.. cases per 100,000 people, positivity rate, new youth cases) appear as long as multiple outbreaks are not occurring in our school	38.00% 415
I would prefer 5 days of in-person instruction for the second semester if the Madison County COVID metrics such as positivity rate, cases per 100,000, and new youth cases were at low levels and outbreaks were not occurring in the school.	26.47% 289
I prefer the hybrid model rather than 5 days of in-person instruction per week because it allows students to attend in-person for a part of the week while remaining socially distanced at virtually all times within the school.	25.64% 280
