

Required Documents for Residency

During the Edwardsville student registration process legal guardians will be required to provide documentation for both student enrollment and residency. Before enrolling a child, the legal guardian must provide proof of residency. The Illinois School Code states that a child is entitled to enroll in a district wherein he/she resides. The code further defines residence as a physical presence with an intention to remain on a permanent basis with the person(s) who has legal custody of the child. Proof of residency in the Edwardsville School District requires documentation with matching address of residence from each of the following categories to complete the registration process. A total of three (3) proofs of residency are required. If you cannot provide these items when submitting your online registration, please bring the required documentation to Hadley House or District 7 Center for Learning to complete the registration process.

All documents must have a current date and current address visible to be valid.
