Re: **2020-21 Course Selection**

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Beginning this month, your child will begin the process of selecting courses for his/her 2020-21 school year. On January 14-16, EHS counselors will meet with all 9-11 grade students to discuss course offerings. The EHS 2020-2021 Course Handbook is posted on the Edwardsville High School website in the drop down menu of **School Info** or can be accessed at <http://ecusd7.org/ehs/wp-content/uploads/sites/16/bsk-pdf-manager/2019/12/20-21-EHS-Course-Handbook.pdf>.

You and your student should review the course handbook and begin making course selections for next school year. Write your child's course selections on the course selection form found on page 6 of the Course Handbook. Students will also receive a course selection form on January 14-16 when counselors meet with students to discuss course offerings. Parents **must** sign the Course Request Form in order for their child to participate in the course selection process. Students must meet the prerequisites listed in the course description in the Course Handbook to be eligible to take certain courses.

The student's course selections will be entered when your child meets with a counselor on January 20-29, 2020. ***Students are to bring a completed Course Selection Form with parent signature to the meeting with their counselor to enter their course selections.*** The dates for the final course selections with counselors are:

- January 21-22 – Course Selection for juniors
- January 23-24 – Course Selection for Sophomores
- January 27-28 – Course Selection for Freshman
- January 29 – Make-Up Day for ALL GRADES

Parents and students should review the information contained in the front of the course catalog regarding graduation credits, NCAA requirements, dual credit opportunities, etc. Proper course selection is imperative in ensuring that your child meets all of his/her graduation and/or college entrance requirements.
