**Please read and complete both sides of this form.**

Students applying for a parking permit must satisfy all of the items below in order to be eligible. In addition, students with excessive absences may be ineligible for a parking permit.

- 1. All fees & fines must be paid in full to be eligible for a parking permit. No exceptions!**
- 2. Parking Applications may be completed and dropped off to the EHS main office or mailed to EHS.**
3. 2020-2021 SENIORS whose completed applications are submitted and received by July 1, 2020 will be assigned first, then JUNIORS, and then SOPHOMORES.
4. Parking permits may be delayed due to late and/or incomplete turn-in.
5. Parking stickers will not be mailed out and must be picked up at school.
6. Parking stickers will be available at the same time schedules are handed out in late July, and you must have a photo ID to get your parking sticker.
7. You are allowed to have 2 family vehicles on one application with proof of insurance for each vehicle and will receive one sticker for both vehicles.
8. Parking stickers may not be shared - 1 student per sticker. If, at any time, you need a parking space change, it must be approved by an administrator beforehand.

**Parking stickers will not be issued until all items listed below are received.**

1. Attach photocopy of the **STUDENT'S VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE.**
2. Attach photocopy of **INSURANCE CARD** for **EACH VEHICLE.**
3. Attach a check for **\$175** made payable to EHS.

## Student Parking and Driving Rules

The Edwardsville School District provides free bus transportation to every EHS student. Some students, however, prefer to use the privilege of driving to school. **Students are allowed to park only on the designated student parking lots and with an issued parking sticker.**

Students who drive to school must abide by the following rules/regulations:

1. Each student vehicle must have its assigned EHS parking sticker affixed to the inside of the windshield on the driver's side, and the parking sticker must be visible at all times for security whenever the student's vehicle is parked on EHS property.
2. The student vehicles are to be parked in designated areas (EHS Main and Sports Complex parking lots) only. Any student who has been issued a parking permit and who parks anywhere other than his/her assigned space may face consequences, such as the towing of the student's car at the student's/owner's expense, removal of parking privileges, or other consequences.
3. The speed limit is **5 MPH** on EHS property. All traffic signs must be followed. Rules of the road and safe driving practices are required at all times on EHS property.
4. Driving on District 7 property is a privilege that will be extended to only those students who are good EHS citizens. Driving privileges may be revoked for at least 1 quarter for the following reasons:
  - Seven (7) or more suspension days from behavior referrals or attendance issues.
  - Reckless driving.
  - Third time cited for loitering in vehicles or on parking lot.
4. A third citation for failure to display parking sticker may result in after-school detention.
5. Students who leave campus without permission may lose their parking sticker and parking privileges for the remainder of the school year.
6. If someone is parked in your space, please provide the Attendance Office with the license plate number and a brief description of the violator's vehicle. Then, park your vehicle in the far end of the Visitor's Lot for that day only.
7. Inappropriately parked vehicles or vehicles without an authorized parking sticker displayed from the windshield may be towed at the owner's expense.
8. Seniors who graduate early (end of 1<sup>st</sup> Semester) **MUST** turn in their parking sticker to the Attendance Office on the last day of their attendance to receive a partial refund. Please verify that the school has your correct address on file.
9. **Revocation of a parking permit may result in the \$175 fee not being refunded.**
