Welcome to the MissVIC July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023 Wellness Initiative. Employees and spouses enrolled in medical insurance may submit the Physician Verification Form by **June 30, 2023** to be entered into a gift card drawing. Your new program details are outlined in this guide.

What is preventive care?

Preventive care is care you receive to prevent illnesses or diseases. Instead of waiting for symptoms of an illness to get health care services, preventive care aims to keep you from getting sick in the first place.

Examples of preventive care include:

- Annual physical exams
- Health screenings
- Lab tests
- Counseling
- Immunizations

Why is Preventive Care so Important?

Preventive screenings are designed to prevent disease and catch things early, when chances of treatment and cure are better. Almost half of America's population has been diagnosed with a chronic condition including heart disease, cancer, diabetes, asthma and AIDS. Keeping up with the recommended health screenings can help you to better manage or reduce the risk of developing one of these diseases.

Is preventive care enough to avoid developing chronic diseases?

When preventive care is combined with an overall healthy lifestyle, like eating well and exercising, you can greatly decrease your chances of getting a chronic condition in the first place.

Cost of Preventive Care

Thanks for the Affordable Care Act, health insurance plans are required to cover most preventive healthcare at 100% when performed as part of an annual physical by an in-network provider. With no out-of-pocket cost, finances should not be a barrier to maintaining your annual preventive health checkup.

STEPS TO GETTING YOUR WELLNESS EXAM



STEP 1: PHYSICIAN VERIFICATION FORM

Complete an annual physical exam and biometric screening with your primary care physician between **JULY 1, 2022** and **JUNE 30, 2023**. Take this packet with you to your appointment and have your doctor complete and sign the Physician Verification Form. **Remember: your annual routine physical and labs associated with your visit are covered at 100% under your health plan.**

- Have you already received your annual physical within the above timeframe? Take this packet to your physician's office to have the Physician Verification Form completed.

If you do not have a doctor, you can select a doctor within the MissVIC health benefit plan network through United Healthcare. If you need assistance in finding a physician, please go to www.UHC.com. Little clinics and minute clinics do not qualify as Primary Care Visit completion.



STEP 2: SUBMIT YOUR COMPLETED FORM BY JUNE 30, 2023

THE FINE PRINT

The MissVIC wellness initiative is a voluntary wellness program available to all employees covered by the medical plan. The program is administered according to federal rules permitting employer-sponsored wellness programs that seek to improve employee health or prevent disease, including the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, the Genetic Information Nondiscrimination Act of 2008, and the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act, as applicable, among others. If you choose to participate in the wellness program, you will be asked to complete a Physician Verification Form. You are not required to participate in the blood test or other medical examinations. However, eligible employees who choose to participate in the wellness initiative will be entered into a gift card drawing at the end of the year for submitting the completed Physician Verification Form by June 30, 2023.

PROTECTIONS FROM DISCLOSURE OF MEDICAL INFORMATION

We are required by law to maintain the privacy and security of your personally identifiable health information. MissVIC will never disclose any of your personal information either publicly or to the employer, except as necessary to respond to a request from you for a reasonable accommodation needed to participate in the wellness initiative, or as expressly permitted by law. Medical information that personally identifies you that is provided in connection with the wellness program will not be provided to your supervisors or managers and may never be used to make decisions regarding your employment.

Your health information will not be sold, exchanged, transferred, or otherwise disclosed except to the extent permitted by law to carry out specific activities related to the wellness initiative, and you will not be asked or required to waive the confidentiality of your health information as a condition of participating in the wellness initiative or receiving an incentive. Anyone who receives your information for purposes of providing you services as part of the wellness initiative will abide by the same confidentiality requirements. The only individual(s) who will receive your personally identifiable health information are you and your primary care physician.

In addition, all medical information obtained through the wellness initiative will be maintained separate from your personnel records, information stored electronically will be encrypted, and no information you provide as part of the wellness initiative will be used in making any employment decision. Appropriate precautions will be taken to avoid any data breach, and in the event a data breach occurs involving information you provide in connection with the wellness initiative, we will notify you immediately.

You may not be discriminated against in employment because of the medical information you provide as part of participating in the wellness initiative, nor may you be subjected to retaliation if you choose not to participate.
